Certificates

If you are returning to Monmouth Comprehensive School:

Your exam certificates will be distributed to you via your Form Tutor during December 2016.

If you are leaving Monmouth Comprehensive School:

Exam certificates will be available for collection from Main Reception from Thursday 1st December 2016. If you are unable to return and collect your certificates yourself please contact the school and we will help you to make alternative arrangements. We prefer certificates to be collected to avoid damage to or even loss of them in the post.

Post Results Services

Post Results Advice and Guidance Day (9.30am – 2.00pm)

: Tuesday 30th August 2016

An opportunity for you to discuss your course choices and future pathways with members of the Sixth Form and School Senior Leadership Team prior to Sixth Form Registration Day and the start of term.

Year 11 students may wish to discuss their Year 12 course choices; Year 12 students might be reflecting on their AS results, courses for Year 13 and their post Sixth Form pathways.

The Post Results Service deadlines for making applications to the Awarding Bodies are as follows:

Last date to apply for Priority Service 2 Enquiries about Results (Candidates place in Higher Education depends on the outcome)

: 26 August 2016

Last date to apply for **photocopies** of scripts (To support decisions whether or not to make Enquiries about Results- photocopies should be

returned to centres by 10th September).

Last date to apply for an Enquiry about Results (Clerical check or remark)

: 20 September 2016

Last date to apply for a copy of your **original** exam script : 4 October 2016

There are fees associated with all of the services above. A consent form must be signed by you before an enquiry can be made on your behalf.

If you wish to make an application for any of the above Post Result Services or if you have any queries regarding your results we would recommend that you speak to your teacher or the Subject Leader as soon as possible. They will be able to discuss your results with you and help you decide if an application is appropriate.
