Dear Parent

The Humanities Faculty are delighted to announce that we are visiting Rome next Easter April 14th to 18th 2019. The trip will be open to GCSE, AS and A2 students of History, R.S., Philosophy & Ethics and Geography. I think you'll agree that our itinerary looks most exciting and supports the GCSE History, RS and A-Level curricula as well as being of profound interest to students who enjoy and are thinking of pursuing further academic studies in Classical History, Classics and Geology. **All students will be travelling on their own passports.**

The itinerary includes:

- A guided tour of Ancient Rome including the Colosseum and Roman Forum - A visit to the Visit Piazza Navona, the Pantheon, the Trevi Fountain & Spanish Steps - A guided tour of the Vatican Museums & Sistine Chapel and visit St Peter's Basilica - A guided tour of EUR area & Mussolini's Rome - A day trip to Pompeii

The cost includes:

- UK transfers - Return flights from to Rome (hand luggage only) - Airport transfers in Rome - 4 nights half board accommodation at a 3/4* hotel, centrally located in the Termini Station area of Rome (continental breakfast & evening meal at a local restaurant) - Entrance to all places of interest - Transport - Group insurance - ATOL Protection Charge - Rome city tax

Based on 45 students the cost of the visit is £712.00. **This is a first come first served trip.**

PAYMENT DETAILS: Your place is confirmed by your payment. A Deposit payment of £112.00 is required on sign up. The outstanding balance is to be paid in equal monthly payments (£120.00) no later than 1st of each subsequent month, commencing in July and to be completed no later than 1st December 2018. If you join the trip after June 2018 your initial payment will be required to be in line with the payment schedule above.

CLOSING DATE: 14th June 2018 or sooner! – The trip will be advertised on ParentPay until the 45 places are taken or the closing date, whichever is soonest.

CONSENT: On line consent available upon payment via ParentPay. You will be prompted for an emergency contact name, number, email address, medical/dietary and details of a current passport and EHIC. (If you do not have a current passport/EHIC this will not affect your ability to process your payment). You are also agreeing that you are aware of the details below.

1. Off-site activities travel and personal injury insurance is provided by Royal Sun Alliance. For summary of cover, please visit the School's website at www.monmouthcomprehensive.org.uk under Trips.
2. I agree to adhere to the payment requirements.
3. I give permission for my child to travel by private hire
4. My child must bring their relevant medication/equipment, including inhalers, on this trip
