Did you know?

- Every 6 minutes someone in the UK dies from a heart attack
- Being able to do CPR more than doubles their chance of survival.
- To date 2.6 million people have been trained through Heartstart.

Places are free and available to anyone aged 10 years and older. Places are limited to 12 participants for the 2 hour session and must be booked through Monmouth Comprehensive Friends Association
