## PROJECT UPDATE

It has now almost been 12 months since we started our work on site at Monmouth Comprehensive School and whilst the first few months were mainly dust and noise, the project is now entering an extremely interesting and crucial part of the construction phase.

Teachers, Students and Parents can now see that the main outline of the new school is forming quickly. This is being created through the use of an entirely British steel frame, which is currently being erected by hundreds of skilled workers every day pulling together all of these critical elements that will aid the holistic functioning of the new school.



These impressive engineering and logistics skills are helping in the preparation for the new secondary school to make way for a 21st century school with state-of-the-art educational facilities for all 11 to 18 year olds. The new school

is on schedule for occupation at the start of the new school term in September 2018. In little over 12 months time, the County Council's vision to provide more than just a bricks and mortar environment for our children will be realised.



The '21st Century Schools and Education Programme' is about adding vibrancy and value to the local community as well as supporting economic and community-led benefits whereby we are currently working with both Monmouth Comprehensive School and other local partnerships in identifying opportunities for apprenticeships alongside training and vocational opportunities.

As the project now progresses through some very interesting stages in terms of the build programme, we will be producing regular newsletters with the aim of keeping teachers, parents and the pupils informed.
