Dear Parent

4 days 3 nights

The Mathematics Faculty are delighted to once again offer the opportunity for students currently in years 8,9 and 10 to visit Paris next year to enhance their appreciation of mathematics in the real world.

The trip will depart on Friday 22nd February and return on Monday 25th February 2019. During the trip students will discover the beauty of mathematics through a wide range of enrichment activities. They will learn how mathematics influences the design of a theme park by visiting Disneyland Paris. Students will look at the architecture and engineering of the city’s key landmarks including the Arc de Triomphe, The Louvre and a stop off to visit the Eiffel Tower during a guided tour of the city. This trip will have many cross-curricular links with French, Science, Design & Technology, Art and Geography.

Based on 50 students the cost of the visit is £450.00. **This is a first come first served trip.**

The trip includes executive coach travel to Paris including Eurotunnel crossings, 3 night’s hotel accommodation at Campanile MLV Torcy (half board), entrance to both Disneyland parks, Eiffel Tower entrance and an evening entertainment show – ‘The Wild West Buffalo Show’, inclusion in the group passport, insurance and a personalised hoodie. It does not, however, include pocket money, lunches or meals en route. **All students who are British Citizens will be travelling on a Collective Passport.**

PAYMENT DETAILS: Your place is confirmed by your payment. A Deposit payment of £75.00 is required on sign up. The outstanding balance is to be paid in equal monthly payments (£75.00) no later than 1st of each subsequent month, commencing in June and to be completed no later than 1st October 2018. If you join the trip after May 2018 your initial payment will be required to be in line with the payment schedule above.

CLOSING DATE: 23rd MAY 2018 – The trip will be advertised on ParentPay until the 50 places are taken or the closing date, whichever is soonest.

CONSENT: On line consent available upon payment via ParentPay. You will be prompted for an emergency contact name, number, email address, medical and dietary details. You are also agreeing that you are aware of the details below.

2. I agree to adhere to the payment requirements.
3. I give permission for my child to travel by private hire
4. My child must bring their relevant medication/equipment, including inhalers, on this trip
