All students have been studying the properties of fibres and fabrics. They now put this into practice with an in-depth design task. Each student will be given a name of a product and a scenario. They have to identify how that product needs to perform and choose relevant fibres and fabrics as well as design considerations for the product. A3sheets – fully annotated. (2 hours) Week 2 – End of fabric and fibres unit – test paper (2 hours) - Marking scheme will follow towards the end of the week to self-assess. Results for each question to be returned to me and feedback will be given, looking at common areas.
