Dear Parent

The Mathematics Faculty are delighted to offer the opportunity for students currently in Year 10 to visit Paris next year to enhance their appreciation of mathematics in the real world.

The trip will depart on Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> February and return on Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> February 2025, during half term. During the trip students will discover the beauty of mathematics through a wide range of enrichment activities. They will learn how mathematics influences the design of a theme park by visiting Disneyland Paris. Students will explore Paris, viewing the architecture and engineering of the city's key landmarks including the Arc de Triomphe, The Louvre and a stop off to visit the Eiffel Tower during a tour of the city. This trip will have many cross-curricular links with French, Science, Design & Technology, Art and Geography.

Based on 80 students the cost of the visit is £565.00.

The trip includes executive coach travel to Paris, 3 night's accommodation at a Disney partner hotel, entrance to both Disneyland parks, the Eiffel Tower, the Louvre and Arc De Triomphe, all on a half board basis. Insurance and a personalised hoodie will also be included. It does not, however, include pocket money, lunches or meals en route. **ALL students will require their own passport with at least 6 months left after the date of return.**

#### Securing a place:

To secure a space for your child, you will need to request a trip place via parent pay before midday on Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> June. Should the number of students requiring a space exceed 80, places will be awarded using a lottery style random number generator. You will be informed of the outcome via email on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> June, please ensure you check your junk email. **Students that have successfully gained a place on the trip will have until 12 noon on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> June to pay their deposit (£65).** Deposits will not be required until your space has been confirmed.

**Any deposits not paid for spaces after this time will be forfeited and offered to the next person on the list.**

#### Payment Schedule:

5 <sup>th</sup> Instalment:	£100.00 due 1 <sup>st</sup> November 2024	Final Instalment:	£100.00 no later than 1 <sup>st</sup> Decmber 2024

If you join the trip after June 2024, your initial payment will be required to be in line with the payment schedule above.

Due to the nature of the trip, only students with a very good track record of behaviour will be permitted to attend. We reserve the right to refuse a place to any student with a poor record of co-operation and following instructions. If a student is accepted onto the trip and then removed at a later date due to poor behaviour, their refund will be in line with the travel agent's cancellation policy.
