Dear Parent,

As part of Monmouth Comprehensive School's Summer Learning activities (Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> – Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> July) Year 8 will be participating in a number of activities both in and out of school. These activities are designed to offer different learning experiences to those available within their usual timetable. The Monmouth Comprehensive School Friends Association is supporting some of the costs of the events but we ask for a contribution of £25.00 from each child.

## Gilwern Outdoor Centre Activities.

Each form will spend one day away from school with the instructors from Gilwern Outdoor Centre (see below for form schedule). Students will take part in one of three activities, canoeing, climbing or caving, for the whole day. The instructors will be providing the transport, expertise and safety equipment for the day and will be accompanied by a member of MCS staff. Students should bring a packed lunch, sunscreen, water and suitable clothing, see the attached kit list for the day. Note that 8AL and 8MY are out of school on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> July, outside of the 3-day Summer Learning window. This is because Gilwern can only accommodate 2 forms at a time.

## Wye Valley Walk (Thursday 18th July).

Students will be walking a section of the Wye Valley Walk between Brockweir and Monmouth for the day. They will need to bring a packed lunch, water, sunscreen and the appropriate coat and footwear, to be prepared for all weathers.

Students need to wear school PE kit throughout the three days, including appropriate footwear for each activity. Please also ensure they are prepared for the weather conditions, i.e. with a rain jacket, sunscreen, hat, and ample water. On the Gilwern Outdoor Centre Day students should follow the attached kit list. Unless advised by the activity leader, for off site visits students will leave on arranged transport after registration and return in time for home to school transport as normal.

In accordance with the School's Health & Safety procedure failure to give consent will result in your child not being able to take part in these activities. By law these are activities for which we are unable to make a charge. However, we are asking for a contribution of £25.00 towards the overall costs of the events.
