

## Student Parking on the School Site

One aim of the new school project has been to minimise the volume of traffic using the Old Dixton Road and the Burgage, while reducing on-street parking and congestion in the vicinity of the school.

The new school car park is now fully operational for staff and visitor parking; the Bus Bay car park is now available for Sixth Form use. A limited number of permits can now be issued for Sixth Form students.

Sixth Form students who wish to take advantage of this facility will be required to display a numbered parking permit in the front windscreen of their car. For the security of all, CCTV is operational in the bus bay. On signing for the permit they are agreeing to:

1. Display their numbered parking permit clearly in the front windscreen of their car.
2. Provide registration number, and other details of the car they are using. Permits are non-transferrable.
3. Drive safely, adhering to the 5mph speed limit in the bus bay.
4. Only park in designated spaces.
5. Not move their car between 2.30pm and 3.20pm. The School's Traffic Management Policy prohibits the movement of cars during these times as school buses are arriving and leaving.
6. Access the School via the pedestrian gate to the left of barriered staff car park between 6.30am and 8.45am and after 2.45pm or via the main entrance when the gates are closed. Bus bay gates are opened at 6.30am and locked at 10.00pm.

Any failure to comply with these requirements will result in the parking permit being returned and cancelled.
